What does Accreditation mean?

Accreditation is optional for all academies/ colleges/ institutions/ schools/ universities. The goal of accreditation is to ensure that education provided by institutions of higher learning meets acceptable levels of quality. Accrediting agencies, which are private educational associations of regional or national scope, develop evaluation criteria, conduct peer evaluations, and assess whether or not those criteria are met. Institutions and programs that request an agency's evaluation and meet that agency's criteria are "accredited" by the board of that association and are declared 'board certified'.

It is a process that gives public recognition to academies that meet or exceed certain criteria and uphold set standards for the training their students. It is a promise that an academy/ college/ institution/ school/ university. will give the quality of training it claims to offer. It assures the student of approved programs of study, qualified teachers, and adequate tools for learning.

I have decided to undergo the process and expense of private professional Accreditation so that you can be assured of the extent of my education, my professionalism, and the quality of the courses I teach at a reasonable investment.

In order to be approved, I have submitted transcripts and certificates of the courses I've taken, a resume covering the last thirty plus years in energy healing, and a catalogue of courses offered through the Academy of Energy Healing. This goes before the board of the International Natural Healers Association for approval. I'm happy to report, I've been 'board certified'.
